

Lead with faith ~ Protect your family ~ Serve others ~ Defend your values



Friends, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord is celebrated on February 2, forty days after Christmas. By bringing Jesus to the Temple, Mary and Joseph followed God's law faithfully. We look to Mary and Joseph as examples of faith and obedience. They trust-

ed God's plan even when it meant difficulty or pain. They show us how to surrender to God's will with faith. Pope John Paul II designated the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord as the Annual World Day of Consecrated Life. So, all our consecrated women and men are invited to return to the beginning, to the very personal early days of the gift of their vocation, recalling, for a moment, the first time you sensed the Lord's call to you to follow Him with an undivided heart.

This feast celebrates three main ideas. First, Jesus is recognized as the Light of the World, a light for all people. Second, it shows that Jesus came to fulfill the law, not to destroy it. He and His family obeyed the customs of their people. Third, it honors the deep faith of Mary and Joseph, who followed God's will at every step. In the Gospel of Luke, we read about two holy people, Simeon and Anna, who meet Jesus at the Temple. They have waited their whole lives for this moment. Simeon praises God and calls Jesus a "light for revelation to the Gentiles." This points to Jesus' mission to save not only Israel but also all nations.

Today the Church invites us to remember that Jesus brings light to our lives. Like Simeon and Anna, we are called to recognize Jesus in our world. Simeon knew that Jesus was the Savior sent for all people. He told Mary that a sword would pierce her own soul. This meant that Mary would suffer as she witnessed the struggles and suffering of her Son. This prophecy prepared Mary for the difficult road ahead. Anna's joy and faith show her love for God and her understanding that Jesus would bring salvation. When she saw Him, she began to give thanks to God and spoke about Jesus to everyone around her.
