"Eternal Rest Grant Unto Them O Lord!



Friends, the readings this weekend remind us of the importance of trust, faith, and humility in our lives. Reflecting on these themes can strengthen our relationship with God and guide us in our daily actions. Elijah asked a widow for water and bread. The widow acts on faith. The widow trusts Elijah's word from God and is blessed with food. The prophet, the widow and her son get endless sup-

plies. This is a spiritual lesson of the "law of gift" where giving selflessly leads to abundance. St. John Paul II said, your being increases the measure that you give away.

Psalm 146 says, "The Lord is faithful, just, and caring. He provides for the needy, frees captives, and protects the vulnerable. He will reign forever". In the Gospel Jesus praised a poor widow who gave all she had. Jesus teaches that true generosity comes from giving all we have, not just from our surplus. She gives away everything she had. We will be judged by the spirit of generosity and love behind our giving, not the amount we give. This reflection challenges us to give like the widow, wholeheartedly and sacrificially. Jesus' offering of himself is the ultimate act of love and service. Do we give everything over to God, not just money, but our time, worries, joys and our life?

The logic of the world is to fill yourself up with more and more. God' logic is to give away even the little you have, and you will find it multiplied. When things are going tough trust rather than thinking about how I can summon my powers. But make an act of trust in faith and be attentive to the strange and surprising ways that God responds to you. Be attentive to the people who God sends our way. That person may seem to be a less likely person who can give what I need right now.
